FAITH NEVER GIVES UP...DON'T QUIT

When we open the Word of God (Bible) we shouldn't look at it with Baptist eyes, Methodist eyes, Catholic eyes or Pentecostal eyes, we just need to read and believe to the best of our ability to what the Word says is TRUTH!

God's Word is pure and true. When it is read and believed (in the heart) it will set us free from any bondage.

Most people who have a problem want to get rid of it. They want to be able to live their lives without stress and worry. They want to live without the bill collector calling every day. They want to live, set free from the sicknesses and family feuds that trouble so many.

Jesus told us the way to be free, *John 8:31-32 (AMP)*

³¹ *So Jesus said to those Jews who had believed in Him, If you abide in My word [hold fast to My teachings and live in accordance with them], you are truly My disciples.*

³² *And you will know the Truth, and the Truth will set you free.*

Let's take a close look at what Jesus said. First of all, He said that we should ABIDE in His Word. That means that we are to continue in, live in and take up residence in His Word. When you are facing a problem in your life, look to the Word and see what the Bible says about that specific problem. The Word has the answer!

For instance, if you are having a problem with your children, then look to the Word of God concerning that problem. Proverbs 11:21 says, ***"The posterity [children] of the righteous will be delivered."*** If the problem is financial, look at Luke 6:38, ***"Give and it will be given to you; good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running***

over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."

Whatever the problem, look in the Word for the answer and abide in it. Do not give up. The Greek word for "abide" can also be translated "continue." To continue means to not quit or give up. If God says it in His Word, then that settles it.

Next, we are to KNOW the truth. That comes from knowing God's Word, in the same way that a husband and wife KNOW each other. It is knowing what God says and going one step further and believing Him. Titus 1:2 and Hebrews 6:18 (the two most important Scriptures in the Bible) say that it is IMPOSSIBLE for God to lie, and God CANNOT lie. So, as we are reading the Word and abiding in it, we also need to believe Him.

Don't look to the flesh to see if it is working...2 Corinthians 5:7, says ***"For we walk by faith not by sight."*** Don't give up! When you know that you know that what you are believing for is God's will for you and promised in His Word, then DO NOT QUIT doing what God has told you to do. Continue to believe His Word and continue to confess His promise in the face of what you see and what you feel.

Instead of reacting to the senses produced by the world, we must act according to the Word spoken by God. His Word brings deliverance and the words of the world bring destruction. When you feel like giving up, quit going by what you feel. Stand in faith and encourage yourself in what Jesus said, ***Mark 9:23 (KJV)***

²³ Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.

Christian Nationalism? What is it? What did it used to be called?

Point two: **Nationalism** depends on the **nation**

Most nations have an “Honor-shame” culture, where an individual’s worth is based on what group they belong to, for example:

ANCIENT EGYPT’S social classes with the Pharaoh’s family on top;

INDIA’S caste system has four major castes and many minor ones;

IMPERIAL CHINA had the Hundred Family Surnames;

EUROPEAN classes divided royalty from peasantry;

ISLAMIC unmah communities consider men worth more than women, who worth more than infidels.

COMMUNIST PARTY members are worth more than common people;

ATHEISTIC utilitarianism gives more value to those contributing to “the state.”

The latest rendition of this “intersectionality,” where a person’s worth is based on how many minority groups they belong to, with “trans” being superior to all others, resulting in those on the left want to impose a “transgender-nationalism.”

President Roosevelt explained, June 14, 1942: “The belief in man, created free, in the image of God—is the crucial difference between ourselves and the enemies we face today.”

President Truman said in his Inaugural Address, January 20, 1949: “The American people...believe that all men are created in the image of God.”

President Eisenhower said November 9, 1954: “Democracy is nothing in the world but spiritual conviction...that each of us is enormously valuable because of a certain standing before our own God.”

Lincoln stated in his Gettysburg Address, 1863: “Our fathers brought forth on this continent, a new nation, conceived in liberty, and dedicated to the proposition that all men are created equal...That this nation, under God, shall have a new birth of freedom, and that government of the people, by the people, for the people, shall not perish from the earth.”

Nationalism is bad in socialist and Islamist nations where governments do not guarantee to individuals inalienable rights, but in America, “nationalism” is supporting a nation whose very purpose is to guarantee to each individual their God-given rights.

These rights include freedom of conscience, religion, speech, press, assembly, self-defense, impartial trial, no cruel and unusual punishment—the freedom to determine their own destiny.

Eisenhower said February 20, 1955: “The founding Fathers...recognizing God as the author of individual rights, declared that the purpose of government is to secure those rights.”

Point #1: Nationalism is the opposite of globalism;

Point #2: Nationalism depends on the nation;

Point #3 (next month) Christian nationalism used to be called Christian Patriotism, (and past Presidents, Democrat and Republican, encouraged it.)

2nd Chronicles 7:14,

14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
